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First Step

- ❖ Brainstorm
 - ❖ Pick music or soundtrack
 - ❖ Decide on concept
 - ❖ Costumes, Makeup and Hair
 - ❖ Be aware of all body types
 - ❖ Flags
 - ❖ Props and other miscellaneous items

Music In Time

- ❖ Make sure the time meets time requirements for your classification
 - ❖ Novice - Minimum 3 mins. - Maximum 4.30 mins - Equipment Time 3 mins.
 - ❖ Regional A - Minimum 3 mins. - Maximum 4.30 mins - Equipment Time 3 mins.
 - ❖ A - Minimum 4 mins. - Maximum 5.30 mins - Equipment Time 3.30 mins.
 - ❖ Open - Minimum 4 mins. - Maximum 6.30 mins - Equipment Time 3.30 mins.
 - ❖ World - Minimum 4 mins. - Maximum 7.30 mins - Equipment Time 3.30 mins.

railroad worker, passenger, conductor, engineer, hobo, victim killed by train

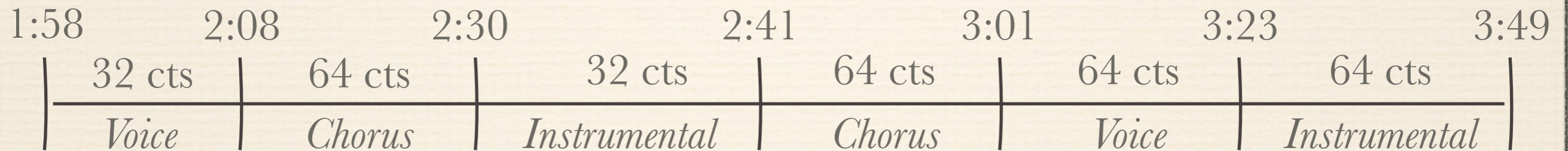
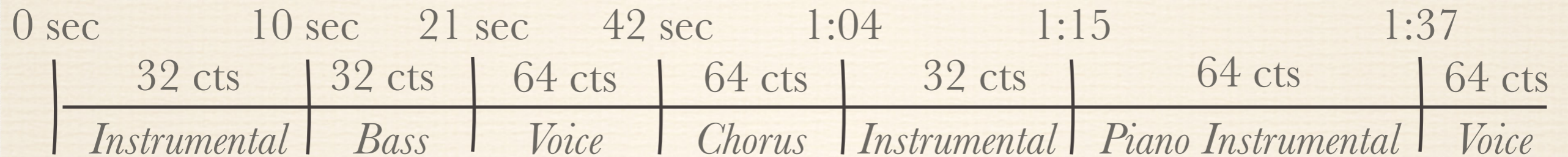
The Show

- ❖ Start with the end in mind
- ❖ Remember the show is a living and breathing object
- ❖ Will change as performers achieve and perfect

Horizontal Timeline

- ❖ Break down the music in time
- ❖ What's happening in the music
adding of instruments, chorus, bridge, accents,
highs and lows
- ❖ Break down time in counts
- ❖ Establish the vertical moments will happen

Horizontal Timeline



Vertical Timeline

- ❖ Decide when effects will happen
- ❖ Decide what type of effect will happen (i.e. rifle, flag, dance, saber or drill)
- ❖ How many and who will create the effect
- ❖ Establish a plan to enter and exit events
